### ATHLETIC / ACTIVITY CODE OF CONDUCT

A student participating in the athletic or activity program at Wilmington Middle School will be subject to disciplinary action if he or she violates the Athletic/Activity Code of Conduct. Student-athletes and activity participants shall not:

- a. use a beverage containing alcohol;
- b. use tobacco in any form
- c. use, possess, buy, sell, barter, or distribute any illegal substance or paraphernalia
- attend a party or other gathering and/or ride in a vehicle where alcoholic beverages and/or controlled substances are being consumed by minors
- e. steal, vandalize or participate in any other illegal activity
- f. act in an unsportsmanship manner
- g. violate the written rules for the activity or sport
- h. behave in a manner which is detrimental to the good of the team, group, or organization
- falsify any of the information contained on required paperwork for participation

Violations in the Code of Conduct will be cumulative in nature across athletic seasons and throughout the entirety of a student's middle school career.

#### CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATION (ITEMS A-E).

1st Offense:

Alcohol and other drug violations, including use, possession, buying, selling, bartering or distributing / Attendance at a party/gathering or riding in a vehicle where alcoholic beverages and/or controlled substances are being consumed by minors / Use of tobacco in any form: A suspension from all co-curricular activities during the season that the offense occurred.

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense:

A one calendar year suspension from all practices and activities.

#### CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATION (ITEMS F-I)

(during periods of suspension, students will be expected to attend all scheduled practices)

Sanctions for a student's failure to comply with items E-I of the Athletic / Activity Code of Conduct will be based on the nature of the offense and the number of offenses, and may include suspension from all athletics or activities:

- A. for a specified period of time or percentage of events/competitions/practices
- B. for the remainder of the season or for the next season
- C. for the remainder of the student's middle school career

## Agreement to Participate

District 209U considers athletics and co-curricular activities to be very important components of the overall middle school experience. These experiences can greatly enhance a student's enjoyment of his or her middle school career, and are helpful in the attempt to develop well-rounded young adults. Co-curricular programming is designed to promote the development of lifelong skills such as self-discipline, leadership, teamwork, respect for self and others. While the regular curricular program is a right afforded to each student, participation in the co-curricular program is a privilege, and as such carries significantly increased expectations beyond those applicable to students within the classroom. The Athletic / Activity Code is established for students who choose to take part in the co-curricular program. By choosing to participate in an athletic or activity program, a student is deciding to extend his or her school day and to subject him/herself to increased expectations regarding behavior or conduct during school hours, at schoolsponsored events, and within the community. The Athletic/Activity Code is considered to be in effect at all places-and times throughout the entirety of any given athletic season, beginning with the first day of practice and ending at the conclusion of the final contest. I have been informed of the guidelines and code of conduct involved in participation in co-curricular activities/sports at Wilmington Middle School and understand it's terms. I will abide by all guidelines and conduct rules in a sportsmanship manner, and will follow the coach's/sponsor's instructions completely.
